- b) Private Room : 10% concession

2. Columbia Asia

- a) Customized Health Checkup Program. : 05% concession
- b) OPD

- 10% off on Consultation Only
- 10% off on LAB + Radiology

c) Inpatient care / Hospitalization

- 10% off on Room Rents
- 10% off on Doctor Charges
- 10% off on LAB
- 10% off on Radiology
- 10% off on procedures

OPD:

IPD:

1. For Hospitalization Services on credit in case of emergency, employee should carry signed authorization letter from the HR or Concerned Authority or should produce the same within 12 hours of admission.
2. Columbia Asia will not take deposit from the employees of PSPCL, PATIALA at the time admission.
3. Cashless treatment would be extended to the employees who are covered by health insurance subject to an approval from the insurance company and initial deposit for the consumables will be charged.
4. Payment for IPD treatment to be made directly by the Employee and dependents.
